Comberton Tennis Club are very grateful to the Cambridge Light Concert Orchestra and their Guest Artists for giving this concert in aid of our Hard Courts Fund.

The Club has been in existence for over twenty years and has grown steadily in membership over that time and now stands at around sixty. It has always been a "working" club with members giving up much of their time in maintaining the courts. As a result of this, subscriptions have been kept at a modest level so that anyone wishing to play tennis would not be prevented from doing so. New members are always welcome.

The time has come when more playing facilities are required and now that the Recreation Ground has been extended, space is available. The Club has wanted Hard Courts for some time but has been prevented from having them by the high cost. Recently however, the Parish Council decided that hard courts should be provided if grants could be obtained and the Club was prepared to make a substantial contribution to the cost. Grants totalling 50% of the cost have been made by the County Council and the Chesterton R.D.C. with the balance to be provided by the Tennis Club and the Parish Council. Construction is scheduled to commence in September 1972.

The Club has been holding various fund raising activities and to date has over £200 in it's Hard Courts Fund. Over £100 has been raised this year. It is hoped to at least double this amount by this time next year. Other activities are planned so watch for details of these. Your support and at other fund raising events is very much appreciated and once again, our thanks to the Orchestra.

We would also like to acknowledge the co-operation of the College Authorities and Derek Oxer, Esq. at the Post Office for selling tickets in advance.
