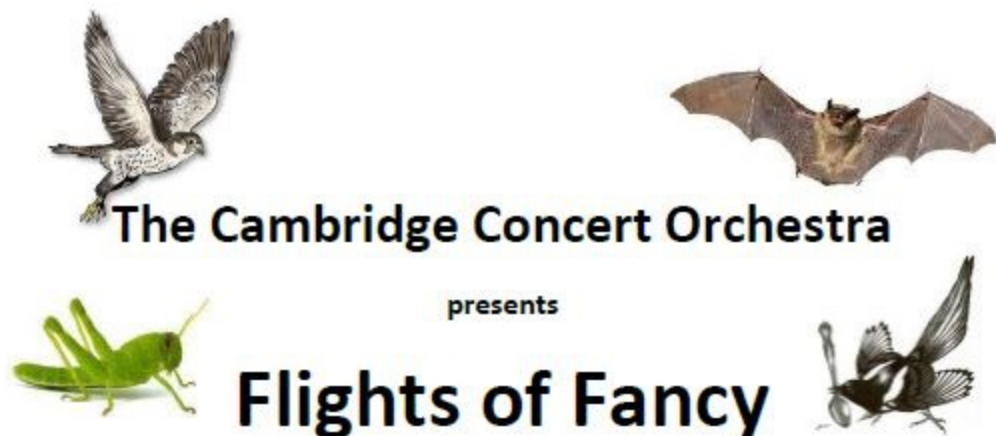
Enquiries from musicians wishing to join us are welcome, particularly violinists. We rehearse in the north of Cambridge in term-time throughout the year.

Freedom from Torture

Torture attempts to silence and break people. Freedom from Torture (FFT) helps survivors to find their voices again and to rebuild their lives.

Each week, 69 full-time and 101 part-time staff are joined by 190 volunteers in Freedom from Torture centres in Birmingham, Glasgow, London, Manchester and Newcastle. Staff and volunteers work with survivors of torture and organised violence to help them rebuild their lives by providing counselling, group therapy and ongoing support and by running groups like gardening, music, creative writing and cookery. FFT also provides expert medical assessments to support survivors' asylum claims and we use our expertise and evidence to protect and promote survivors' rights and hold torturers to account.
